Create All entries must reflect the contest theme and represent the original, independent effort of the student. Before creating your entry, please carefully review the requirements and guidelines.

Submit All entries must be accompanied by a Contest Submission Form. The deadline for all entries is March 23, 2016. To submit a form and entry, visit <http://holocaust.georgia.gov/2016-submit>.

Prizes First through third place winners will be recognized at the Days of Remembrance ceremony in the State Capitol on May 6, 2016. First place winners will receive an iPad mini. Further prizes will be announced.
